

Tanah Merah Country Club Tampines Course



The Rules of Golf of the R&A shall govern play, as modified by the following Local Rules, adopted by the Committee as permitted by the R&A.

Local Rules (Tampines Course)

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

As indicated by white stakes or lines.

2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Penalty areas are defined with either red or yellow stakes. The red penalty areas on H1, 2, 5, 10, 11 and 12 defined on only one side extends to infinity along with back of green 5 and 8. The boundary fence within the red penalty area is an integral part of the course. All bridges are deemed to be in the Penalty area.

3. DROP ZONES

If a ball is in the penalty area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each with one penalty stroke:

- take relief under Rule 17.1, or
- as an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the Drop Zone.

The Drop Zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

4. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (NO RELIEF)

Stones / concrete embankments / retaining walls / railway sleepers/ cart paths lying within the margin of a Penalty Area. Rock landscapes and waterfalls.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

The followings are Immovable Obstructions in the general area: Bases of trees bordered by concrete or stones, distance markers, penalty area stakes, directional signs, young trees/plants identified by orange stakes or paint, halfway house, rain shelters, buggy paths and their related construction, lamp posts, sand containers, sprinkler heads, drainage sumps, manhole covers, ground marked with "GUR" or "Flower Bed" signs and other artificial surfaces and constructions (except as declared as integral parts of the course).

A player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b, if his/her ball is outside the penalty area.

6. EDGING GROOVES NEAR PUTTING GREEN

The edging grooves around the aprons or fringes of putting greens are ground under repair. If a player's ball lies in or touches a groove or a groove interferes with the area of intended swing, the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1d (placing ball). Interference does not exist if the edging groove only interferes with the player's stance.

CONTROL OF PLAY

- Golf buggies must not be driven by persons under 16 years of age.
- Golfers are to play from tee-boxes that match their playing abilities according to the handicap Index.

TEE HANDICAP INDEX

Black Men.	9.9 & Below
Blue Men.	18.0 & Below
White Men.	24.0 & Below
White Ladies.	9.9 & Below
Red.	40.0 & Below

PACE OF PLAY

Players playing from an inappropriate Tee-Box and causing delay will be redirected by marshals to play from appropriate Tee-Box. The guided time is 2 hr 10 mins - front nine / 2 hr 10 mins - back nine. Keep up with the group in front and speed up play if a gap occurs. Invite the group behind to play through if holding up play, irrespective of the number of players in the flight.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty

(Loss of hole in Match Play, 2 strokes Penalty in Stroke Play)
