

The Rules of Golf of the R&A shall govern play, as modified by the following Local Rules adopted by the Committee as permitted by the R&A.

## LOCAL RULES (GARDEN COURSE)

### 1. BOUNDARY LINES / RED PENALTY AREAS

The Red Penalty areas extends to infinity on Holes 1,2,3,4,5 and 9 and as defined beyond Greens of Hole 5 and 8.

### 2. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (No Relief)

- Stones / Concrete Embankments / Boundary Fences Retaining Walls / Cart Paths lying within the margin of a penalty area.
- Rock Landscapes and Waterfall.

## 3. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Yellow Stakes / Lines Red Stakes / Lines

If a ball is in or is known or virtually certain is lost in Penalty Area, the player may proceed under Rule 17, or as an additional option, a player may under penalty of one stroke, PLACE a ball on the artificial mat Drop Zone, available.

If a ball is in the penalty area, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball has not been found to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options

- take relief under Rule 17.1 or
- as an extra option, drop the original ball or
- another ball in the Drop Zone. The Drop Zone is a Relief Area under Rule 14.3

## 5, DROP ZONE

- (i) All Immovable Obstructions shall include:
- Staked Trees
- Lighting Poles at #09 and #18
  Open Drains (unless marked as OB or lying within the margin of the penalty area). Ground marked with "GUR" sign, young trees or plants marked with orange stakes, lines or paint. Flower Beds marked specifically with Flower Bed Sign (Rule 16)
- (i) Edging Grooves The edging grooves round the aprons or fringes of putting greens are ground under repair.If a ball rest in or on an edging groove around a putting green, the ball may be lifted, cleaned and PLACED at the nearest position to where it lay that is not nearer the hole. The position may be on or off a putting green. No relief is available for interference with players' stance.

PACE OF PLAY:
For the purpose of pace of play, golfers are to play from the appropriate tee-boxes as set out below:

Blue Tee Men - 18.0 & below White Tee Men - 24.0 & below / Ladies - 9.9 & below Red Tee Ladies - 40.0 & below

Players causing delay will be redirected by Marshals to play from the appropriate Tee-Box. The guided time is 2 hrs 5 mins - front nine / 1 hr 55mins for back nine. Keep up with the group in front and speed up play if gap in front occurs. Invite the group behind to play through if holding up play, irrespective of the number of players in the flight.

GOLF BUGGIES must not be driven by a person under 16 years of age.


